

THE THREE ROCKS OF ALMUÑECAR

The Three Rocks or the 'Peñones del Santo' is a natural monument with the addition of a man-made cross, which was installed in 1900 that crowned the viewpoint square.

There are the rock of outside, rock in the middle and the holy rock, which is the largest with an approximate height of 30 meters, it's the nestled on the beach and it's where we can find the holy cross.

The original cross was inaugurated on April 20, 1901 in commemoration of the first anniversary of the death of D^a Encarnación Márquez, owner of "La encarnación" sugar factory, widow of Rafael Márquez and Osorio-Calvache an one of the most important women powerful of their time.
